NEW YORK, Dec. 1 — Contracts have been signed by representatives of the governments of Soviet Russia and Hungary for participation in the New York World's Fair of 1939, Grover A. Whalen, president of the fair corporation, has announced. The Russian government has contracted to use 110,000 square feet of space, while Hungary will use 36,000 square feet.
